The Wolverine Venture Battle provides an opportunity for all Grove City College students to apply their knowledge by developing a business idea, interviewing customers, prototyping, market testing, and presenting to potential “investors” to win real money and in-kind services. This competition has been deliberately designed for all majors to be comfortable participating. All students who participate hone their presentation skills, explore new ideas, and enjoy hands-on learning.
