## Play a Role in the Battle





# Sponsor + Name Your Own Prize

A unique opportunity to create impact for students and visibility for your organization.

### **How it Works**

If you're an individual or a representative of a company looking for an opportunity to make a sizable (and exciting) impact on students and teams participating in the Wolverine Venture Battle while also gaining valuable visibility, you have the option to name your own special prize. When you choose to name a prize, you agree to make a donation (min \$5,000) where 50% of the donation will serve as a traditional competition sponsorship where those funds will be used to cover competition expenses including supplies for teams, competition day logistics, and marketing.





The remaining 50% of your donation will go toward a special prize named (and awarded) by you or your representative. The name of your special prize could be as simple as your family name (e.g., The ABC Family Prize), a company name (e.g., The XYZ Prize) or adding a general term (e.g., "The XYZ Innovation Prize" or "The XYZ Company Next Generation Entrepreneurship Prize"). Another option is to include the desired prize selection criteria (mutually determined by the company and E+I's executive director) in the name (e.g., The Grove City Foundation Social Impact Prize).
