EARLY SEPTEMBER

Attend Preview Night and apply for open internship opportunities

MID/LATE SEPTEMBER

Interview and match with an organization aligned with your interests and skills

LATE SEPTEMBER - EARLY OCTOBER

Begin your internship, complete pre-placement survey, and establish expectations

OCTOBER - NOVEMBER

Develop skills, contribute to real-world projects, and meet with E+I staff to reflect on growth

DECEMBER + JANUARY

Submit your fall reflection and return in January to take on increased responsibility

FEBRUARY - MARCH

Complete the program with real experience, and submit your final reflection paper and post-placement survey
